

# Major Agricultural Migrant Labor Demand Areas

## (by month and principal crops)

The twelve charts in this booklet show the major agricultural areas in the United States where, each month, migratory agricultural workers are usually employed to supplement local farm labor.

The information from which these charts were developed was supplied by the State employment agencies affiliated with the United States Employment Service.

There is no attempt to indicate the number of out-of-area workers employed within these areas, or the exact duration of their stay. Activity in any crop, as shown on these maps, could be starting, at its peak, or near completion during any month shown.

All crops or crop areas are not included. Only the areas utilizing significant numbers of migrant farm workers are shown. In these areas are grown:





# MAJOR AGRICULTURAL MIGRANT LABOR DEMAND AREAS




