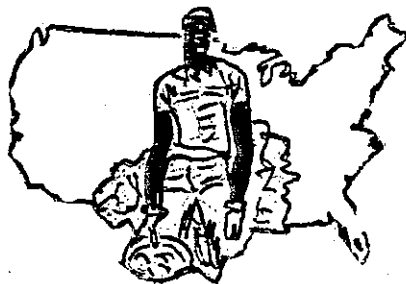

MIGRANT DROPOUT YOUTH PROGRAM

CONSORTIUM STATES SHARED RESPONSIBILITIES

- * CONTRIBUTE STAFF TIME AND/OR OTHER RESOURCES
- * APPOINT A REPRESENTATIVE TO THE INTERSTATE COORDINATING COMMITTEE (ICC)
- * COMPILE A STATE-SPECIFIC OR REGIONAL RESOURCE GUIDE LISTING EDUCATION, TRAINING, EMPLOYMENT AND SUPPORT SERVICES
- * IDENTIFY AND ENROLL MIGRANT DROPOUT YOUTH
- * SUBMIT ENROLLMENT FORMS TO PROJECT DIRECTOR AND COORDINATING AGENCY
- * MAINTAIN FILES ON YOUTH IDENTIFIED AND SERVED
- * SUBMIT PERIODIC REPORTS
- * MONITOR ACTIVITIES OF STAFF
- * CONSULT AND COORDINATE WITH OTHER SEA AND LEA MIGRANT EDUCATION PROGRAMS
- * UTILIZE THE DROPOUT MODEL WITH PERSONNEL SERVING MIGRANT DROPOUTS
- * SERVE AS LIAISON BETWEEN THE SED AND MDYP

MIGRANT DROPOUT YOUTH PROGRAM

STEPS TO SERVING THE INDIVIDUAL MIGRANT DROPOUT YOUTH

THE YOUTH:

1. IS ENROLLED THROUGH A PERSONAL VISIT AND/OR MIGRANT EDUCATION IDENTIFICATION AND RECRUITMENT FORM
2. RECEIVES WELCOME LETTER AND COPY OF REAL TALK
3. RECEIVES CONTINUOUS CORRESPONDENCE
4. IS VISITED BY FACILITATOR AND/OR LOCAL STAFF PERSON WHEN POSSIBLE
5. CALLS MDYP HOTLINE FOR INFORMATION ON ALTERNATIVE SECONDARY OR VOCATIONAL PROGRAM
6. DECIDES TO GET BACK INTO AN EDUCATIONAL/ VOCATIONAL PROGRAM
7. IS REFERRED TO AGENCY: I.E., JOB CORPS, HEP, JTPA
8. REQUESTS ASSISTANCE WITH ENROLLMENT PROCESS
9. ENROLLS IN PROGRAM
10. CONTINUES TO COMMUNICATE WITH MDYP STAFF FOR SUPPORT
