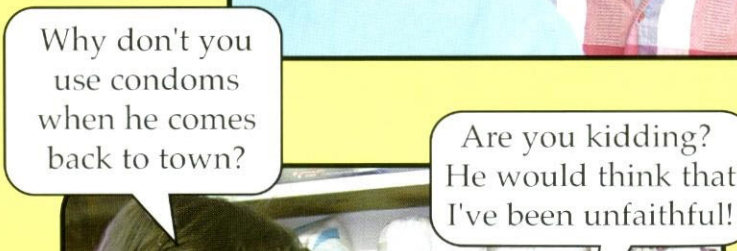
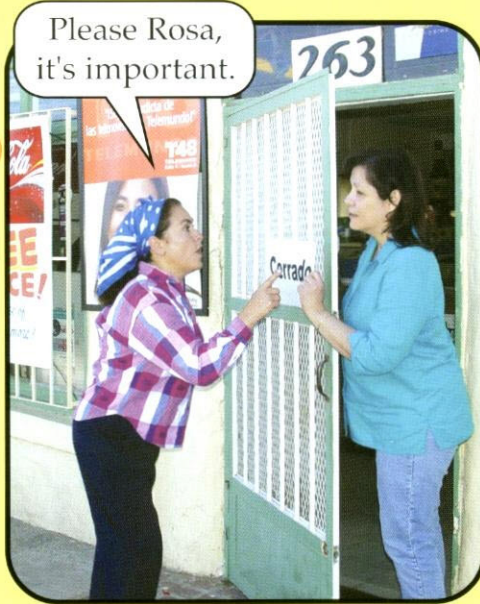

What is HIV?



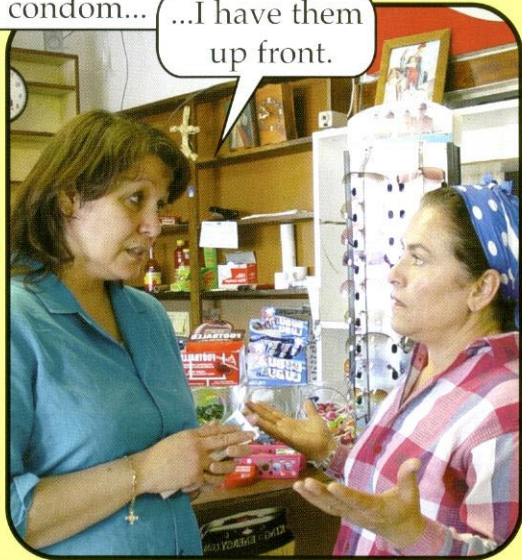
HIV is a sexually transmitted infection!

...I have them up front.

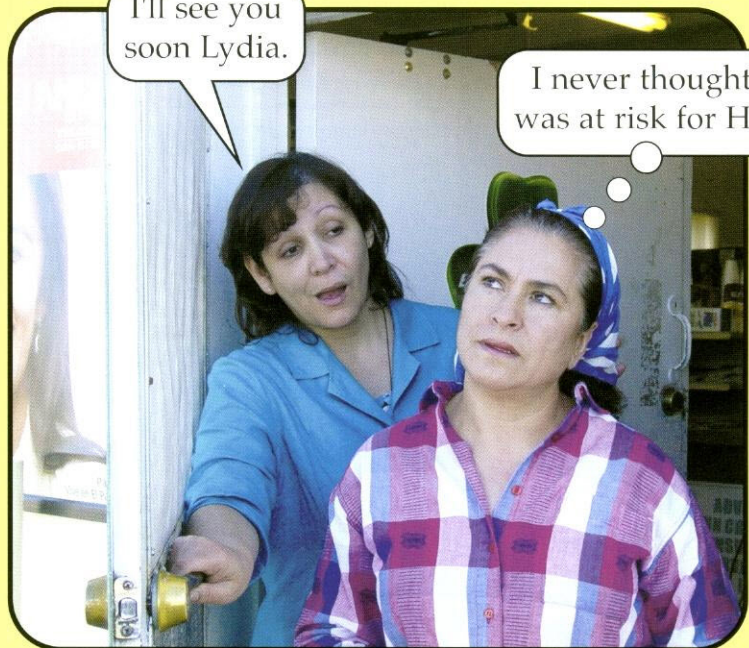


Condoms... I have so much to think about.

I never thought I was at risk for HIV.

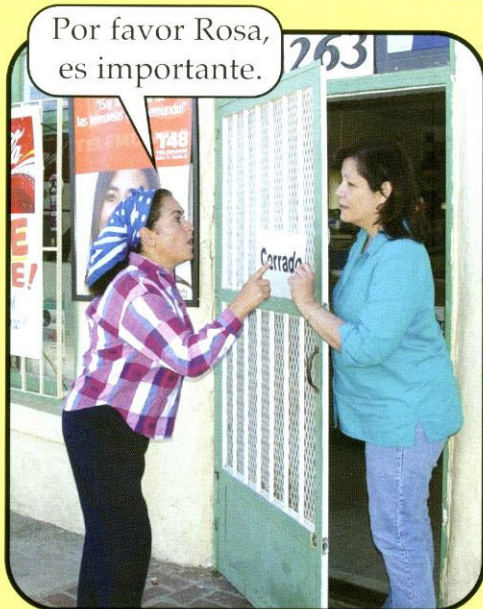
